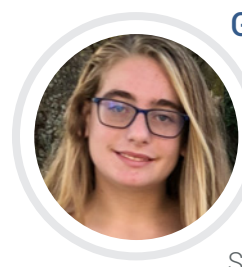

# Installation an Opportunity for Sacred Relationship

A few weeks ago, 10 first graders from our congregation ascended the *bimah* and answered for me a question that I have wondered for a long time: "What is Consecration?" As a child, I was never consecrated, nor was it an event in my previous congregation, so this was my very first one. By all accounts, it was a beautiful, meaningful experience and the students were fantastic. It was a testament to the dedication of these fine children and their families and a wonderful statement about the learning being done in our religious school. It was also a particularly proud moment for Sharon and me as our son, Liav, was among the first graders consecrated that morning.

Having the chance to watch the children and participate in the ceremony helped me understand that Consecration is really an opportunity for making holy a relationship. In this case, it is the relationship between a first grade student, their family, and the synagogue, which was infused with *k'dushah*, extra holiness. In certain ways, this is like a Jewish wedding ceremony in which the purpose is *kiddushin*, the sanctification of a relationship between two loving adults. Consecration is a beautiful way of making holy the relationships that these children and their families have with Tifereth Israel and, of course, with God.

It is that framework which is very much

in my mind as we approach my official installation as senior rabbi at Tifereth Israel. Many ask what an installation is. Other than being a ceremony and a celebration, it is, at its core, an opportunity to make sacred the relationship between a congregation and its rabbi, to bring even more *k'dushah* into our community. I welcome everyone to join us the first weekend of April for this momentous and truly holy occasion.

Details on how you can participate from near and far are included in the pages of this Forum. I would like to say from the start, though, that I am truly honored to be the senior rabbi here and have felt the beauty and majesty in this synagogue from the moment I entered the building as a candidate, almost twelve months ago. My family has felt the warm and welcoming spirit from day one and my children feel at home at Tifereth.

Thank you all, in advance, for your participation and for your contributions toward making this event a successful fundraiser for the synagogue, as well as for your trust in me. I look forward to continuing to build our sacred relationship for many, many years to come.

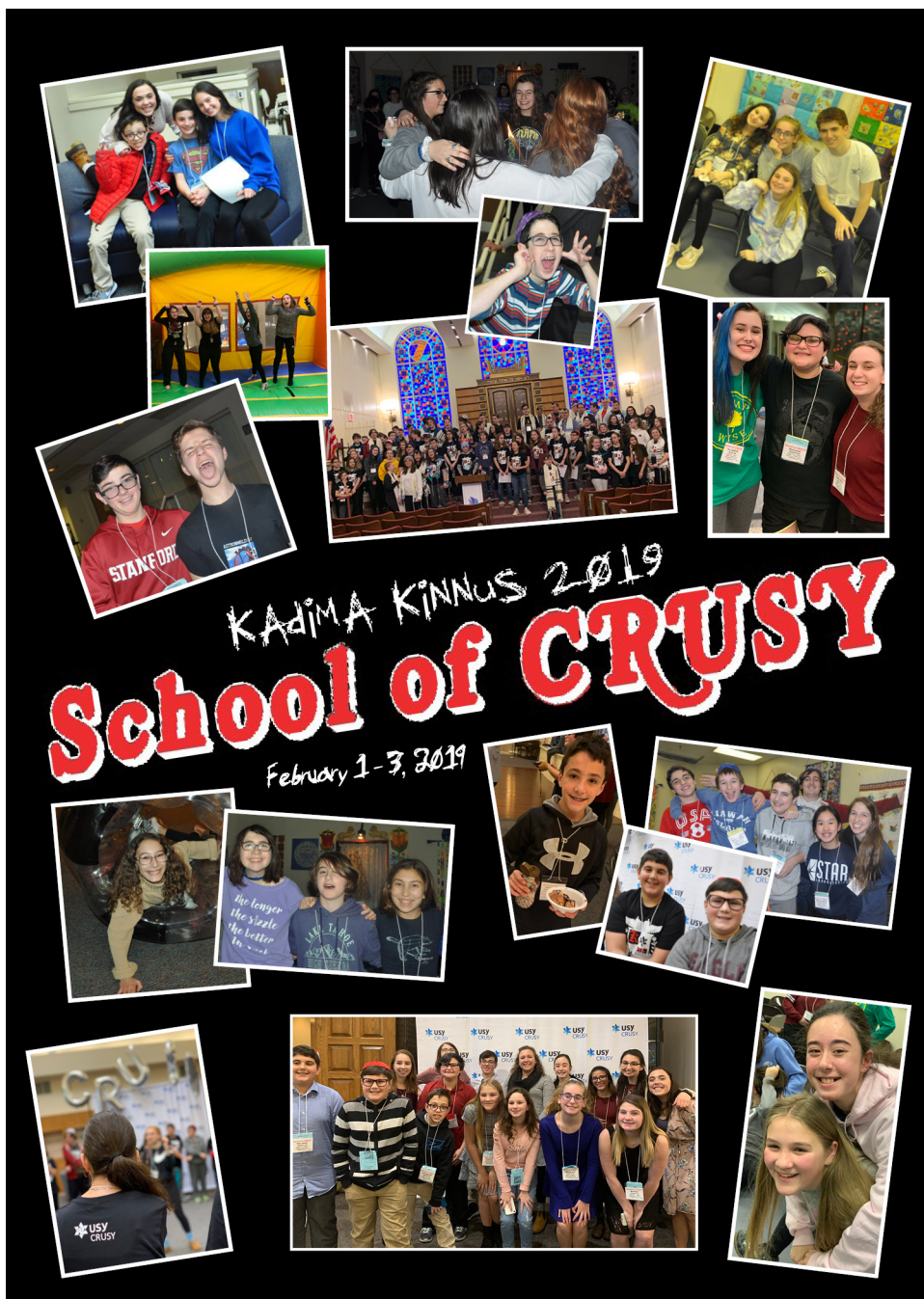


