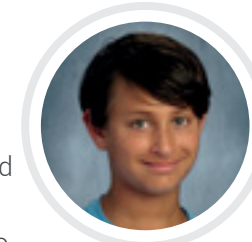

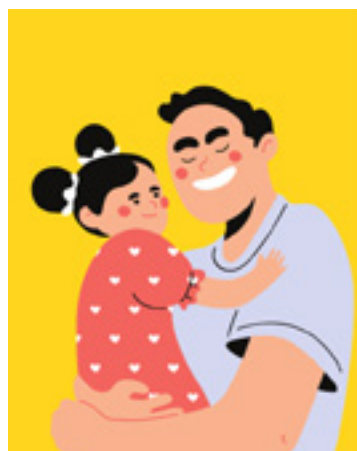

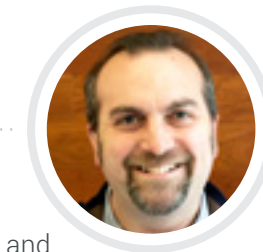

One of the most rewarding experiences I have had in my rabbinate thus far, was leading a congregational trip to Israel in June 2017 from my synagogue in Orlando. Together, 35 of us traveled the country, spending time in Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, Haifa, and Tiberias. We visited the Dead Sea, Masada, and the Western Wall, visited the caves of Rosh Hanikra and ate delicious food everywhere we went. It was an amazing week-and-a-half full of moments that none of us will ever forget.

Between moving from Orlando to Columbus, the pandemic, and life itself, it pains me to say that I have not been back to Israel since then. Several times during my first four years in Columbus I have thought to begin work on a congregational trip to Israel, but each time COVID numbers have gone up and the moment slipped away.

Those of you who were able to join us for services on the first day of Rosh HaShanah heard me speak about my experience in Basel, Switzerland celebrating the 125th anniversary of the very first World Zionist Congress. It was indescribably powerful to be in the room where Herzl and the other delegates sat and to sing Hatikvah in the space where those very people chose to make it Israel's national anthem. Not only did

those moments and others deepen my love for the State of Israel, they reminded me that it is past time once again to *go* to Israel!!

In fact, my dream is to plan not one Israel trip, but two! Over the past few weeks, plans have been coming together for a trip to Israel that will depart in late April 2023 (either the 26th or the 27th) and return on May 9. And at the same time, I am in the early stages of planning a trip for Winter Break 2023! I know we could just do the one trip in December 2023, but frankly I don't want to wait that long to again eat shawarma at my favorite place in Jerusalem. At the same time, I understand that kids will still be in school during late April/early May, hence the two trips.

As these dates are finalized we will be announcing it to the congregation along with pricing and opportunities to join me for information sessions. Perhaps that will have already been set by the time you read these words in the Forum. Either way, I hope you will join me on one or both of these exciting adventures with *Tiyulei Tiferet* / Tifereth Travels. Together we will make memories that will last a lifetime!

## The Web of Eugenics: Scientific Racism's & Antisemitism's Past, Present, and Future
