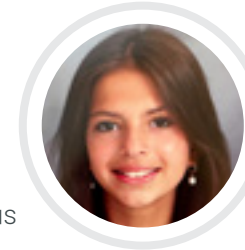

Diane and David invite relatives, friends, and members of the congregation to worship with them and join them on this happy occasion for a luncheon in Sophie's honor.

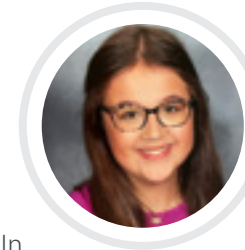

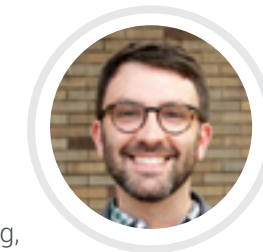

## Torah's Hidden Faces

As the father of a 4-month-old, I tend to have more sleepless nights than I used to. But aside from special time with my new daughter at 4 a.m., some of my favorite sleepless nights were Shavuot evenings, when — in New York, Jerusalem, and here in Columbus — I could stay up late popping into all sorts of fascinating classes and discussions on all sorts of Jewish topics, from mindfulness and yoga to text study and Jewish law to Israeli politics and culture. When I was a rabbinical student and intern, I had the 4 a.m. teaching slot, followed by 6 a.m. services. Nowadays, it really does take a crying baby to get me to wake up at that time.

Still, the practice of late night study — aided by caffeine and cheesecake — is a creative modern take on the practice of ancient Jewish mystics, who stayed up late on the eve of Shavuot studying specific texts to reenact the moment at Sinai and connect with the divine presence.

What's amazing to me is that now, the way we as modern Jews connect with that moment and with that presence isn't through just one set of texts or one type of study, but with a diversity of teachers, opinions, topics, and worldviews. To receive the Torah in 2023 means to be open to Torah in the

many garments it may be wearing, from classical rabbinic sources to modern feminist and LGBTQ perspectives. It means being open to the possibility that any one of the Torah's 70 hidden faces may be present in the face of someone unexpected, even someone with whom we disagree.

Being a part of this community, I am so lucky to get to see those faces in the faces of our community each and every day, whether I'm teaching or learning from members of this community, accompanying folks through simchas or difficult moments, or even in the crucial work of committee and board meetings. And part of why we work so hard to provide such a diverse range of gatherings — prayer and classes, social justice work and purely social gatherings — is because we understand that Torah can be received in all sorts of places and experiences.

We hope you'll join our joint Tikkun Leil Shavuot late-night study with our friends at Agudas Achim and Temple Israel this Shavuot — and then, that you'll continue receiving the Torah with us all, each and every day.

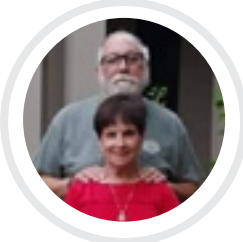

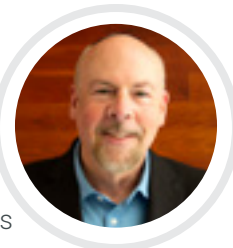

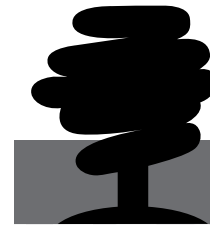
