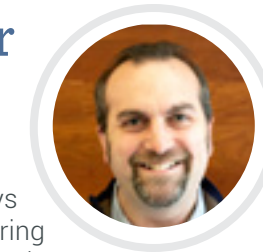

Safe Travels This Summer

At this time of year, as summer is in full swing my mind often turns to "*Tefilat Hadarech*" or what is commonly referred to as "The Traveler's Prayer." To me, it is the perfect prayer to reflect on over the summer when so many people are indeed travelers themselves. As a child, I was always taught that when going on a journey, *Tefilat Hadarech* was to be recited once you made it to the highway. It is, however, worth noting that in Columbus it is quite possible to make it to the airport without ever getting on the highway so if you are concerned, saying it once you board an airplane is also a perfect time to do so.

The prayer itself, included below as translated in the weekday Sim Shalom, is one that asks God to grant us a safe and prosperous journey. We ask God to protect us from any potential dangers along the way including potentially dangerous animals which were no doubt more of a threat in ancient times when travel worked very differently. Still, the idea of beginning any kind of endeavor or adventure by recognizing that so much of what happens is beyond our control is a profoundly spiritual way to

consider journeys we each take during this time of year. There is no small amount of planning that goes into a summer vacation but as we all know, things can so often get in the way of even the best laid plans. Asking God to grant us safety and success on those journeys is a very appropriate way to begin.

What is often missed in this prayer is a phrase that is regularly included in parentheses which asks God not only to have us travel safely to our destination, but also to return us safely to our homes. Some journeys are intended to be a "one-way" trip, but most often we leave on a vacation with the intention of coming back home at the end. It then makes sense that we would want to include a prayer for a safe return.

I hope that as you travel this summer, that your plans include a return to Columbus and that you arrive both at your destination and back here in Columbus safely.

Traveler's Prayer

May it be Your will, Adonai our God and God of our ancestors, to guide us in peace. Prepare us, support us, and lead us to our chosen destination in peace, joy, and well-being, and lead us home again in peace. Protect us from enemies, dangers, and potentially dangerous beasts along the way, from terrors that may confront us. Bring blessing to our endeavors. May we enjoy grace, love, and compassion in Your sight and in the eyes of everyone we meet. Heed our concerns, for You are God, who responds to prayer and petition. Praised are You Adonai, who listens to prayer.

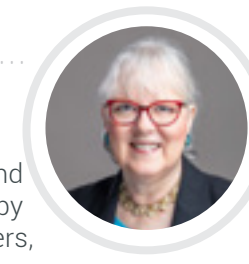

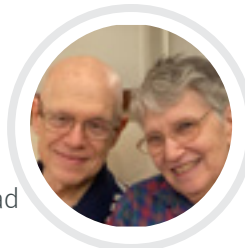

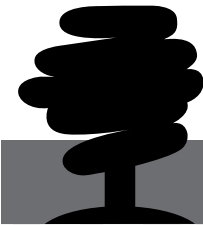
