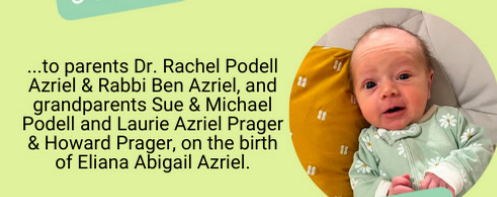

In early December, Jan Lyddon and I had the honor of attending USCJ's Annual Convening. 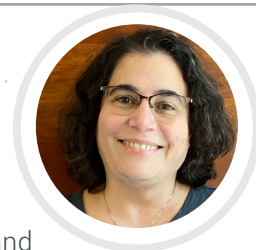
that people know our wonderful clergy, they know our synagogue and what we do here.

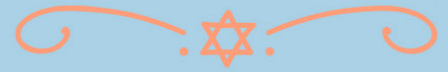

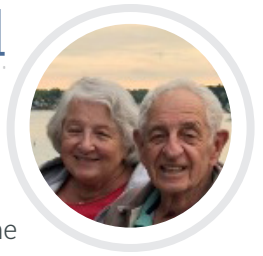

Preparing for Sabbatical

The Torah teaches that even the earth deserves time off.

That's the origin of our tradition's *shemita* practice – the notion that the land should not be worked every seventh year, not because it would make the soil better, but because rest is a sacred gift. This ritual is proof that Judaism knows our value comes not only from what we can produce, but it is simply intrinsic...stemming just from the fact of our existing.

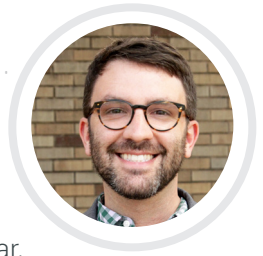
It's also the origin of the modern "sabbatical" practice, when academics and other professionals take time off from their daily, productive duties to find time for other forms of exploration, development, rest, and growth.

For me, the past seven plus years at Tifereth Israel have been the most meaningful and fulfilling period of my life, both professionally and personally. I've taught and studied with you, delivered sermons to you, had coffee with you, sat together with you through deep pain and loss, and celebrated together every chance we could. I've tried and succeeded, tried and failed, tried and muddled through. I've been there for committee meetings, board meetings, task force meetings, staff meetings, planning meetings, *b'nai mitzvah* meetings, pastoral meetings, conversion meetings, and just-checking-in meetings. I've read and sent emails – so, so many emails. Thanks to all of you, I've learned and grown in ways I could never have predicted.

I moved to Ohio as a newlywed, and then, over the past seven years, I got a dog, a house, a kid, and then another kid – so there have been some big changes personally, too.

Now, though, I am so deeply grateful to this congregation for this incredible gift: a chance to take a moment for *shemita* – usually translated as "sabbatical," but derived from the Hebrew word meaning "to release," "to loosen," or "to let go."

For me and my family, it will be a chance to "release" and "let go" of our regular



routine, to adventure and explore, to learn new things. I'm grateful for this chance to go deeper into myself, to rest, to make lots of interesting plans and also to see what happens when I stop planning for a bit. It will be a chance to see what emerges, with the joy of being able to share this all with you when I return.

I'm not very good at "letting go," but for this special time ahead, I'm going to try. And I'll be doing it thanks to the generosity and kindness of this congregation, along with its staff and leadership. Thank you for your trust in me, and for the gift of this sacred time.

FAQ

How long will you be gone?

We'll be leaving on May 1 and returning around the end of August.

What will you be doing?

Traveling! Spending time in Israel for study and relaxation. Seeing some of the Jewish communities my husband works with in Europe through his organization JDC. Taking in the sights, spending time on the beach, playing with my kids. I'll try to post some thoughts, updates, and reflections on social media every now and then ... and if you follow my husband there, I'm sure you'll see some great photos of us and the kids around the world.

I'll also be soaking up some opportunities for continued study and spiritual growth with teachers and institutions that I admire (such as the Hartman Institute) — not because I need to teach a class or give a sermon, but because it fills me up. That said ... I'm sure some of this stuff will filter into sermons and classes when I'm back in Columbus.

Finally, I've been working on a collection of translations and commentaries on the teachings of various Hasidic masters, the radical spiritual mystics of 18th- and 19th-century Eastern Europe who have inspired and challenged me for the past ten years or so. These translations are part of a project that I began during the lowest lows of the COVID pandemic, and I'm looking forward to completing, polishing, and sharing them at some point soon.

Will you be checking email or voicemails?

No! I'll set up an away message with information about who you can be in touch with to answer any questions or resolve any issues — as well as ways to get in touch with me in the case of a true emergency. I will not be back-checking email from this time away upon my return.

Luckily we have an incredible team here at Tifereth, and we are at a moment when our staff is as capable, passionate, and solid as I've ever seen it. And that's not even mentioning my incredible colleague Rabbi Hillel Skolnik, who is the mentschiest of mentsches for picking up so much of the slack while I'm gone. Please go easy on him! I look forward to returning the favor for him soon. In the meantime, a good way to start is to be in touch with our Membership Director Stephanie Hukle. She can help direct all your questions to the right member of our team.

Will you be working at all?

I'm going to try really hard not to! We'll be spending most of our sabbatical time out of the country, so I won't be at services or teaching regular classes. I've worked out with Rabbi Skolnik and our staff how to make sure that all of my regularly scheduled classes are either covered or put on hiatus for the time being. I will be thinking of you all and missing our community, even as I take this meaningful time to recharge and grow in new and different ways.

That said, you will still hear from me over this time! I will probably share a Thought Before Shabbat or two, and plan on doing at least one Zoom Lunch-and-Learn (though for me it will probably be dinner time in Israel).

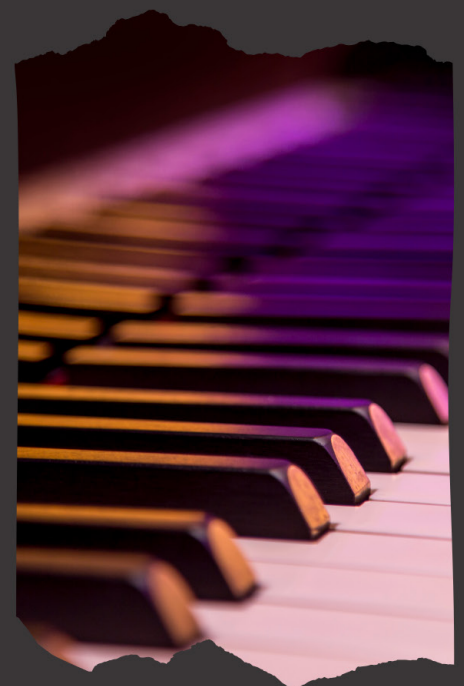
