Join us for another round of the Hebrew Reading Crash Course this summer with instructor Pamela Feldman-Hill. These classes are offered FREE via Zoom and are in partnership with Congregation Tifereth Israel in Columbus, Ohio, the Women of Reform Judaism, and NJOP (the National Jewish Outreach Project.) Past students are encouraged to join us again for a refresher! Registration required.
